3.	When the governor motioned for him to speak, Paul replied: "I know that for a number of years you have been a judge over this nation'so I gladly make my defense. ()	
4.	and I have the same hope in God as these men themselves have, the wicked will also beresurred. ()	
5.	Then Felix, who knew what Christians believed, adjourned the proceedings. "When Lysias the commander comes," he said, "I will decide your case." (
6.	As Paul talked about righteousness, self-control and the judgment to come, Felix was not afraid. and said, "That's enough for now! You may leave. When I find it convenient, I will send for you." ()	
7.	Three days after arriving in the province, Felix went up from Caesarea to Jerusalem.(
8.	They requested Festus, as a favor to them, to have Paul transferred to Caesaria. for they were preparing an ambush to kill him along the way. (X) (Acts 25:3)	
9.	Festus answered, "Paul is being held at Jerusalem, and I myself am going there soon (
10.	But when Paul made his appeal to be trialled by the Emperor, I ordered him held until I could send him to Caesar. ()	
11.	I found he had done deserved to die, but because he made his appeal to the Emperor I decided to send him to Rome. (
12.	Then Agrippa said to Paul, "You don't have permission to speak for yourself." So Paul didn't motioned with his hand and began his defense: (
13.	They have known me for a long time and can testify, if they are willing, that I conformed to the strictest sect of our religion, living as a Pharisee (
14.	I too was convinced that I ought to do all that was possible to obey the name of Jesus of Nazareth. (
15.	Many a time I went from one synagogue to another to have them punished, and I tried to force them to love. I was so obsessed with persecuting them that I even hunted them down in foreign cities. ()	
16.	About noon, King Agrippa, as I was on the road, I saw a light from heaven, brighter than the sun, blazing around me and my friends. (
17.	'At this point Festus interrupted Paul's defense. "You are clever, Paul!" he shouted' "Your great learning is driving you insane." (

18.	When it was decided that we would sail for Italy, Paul and some other prisoners were handed over to a centurion named Julian, who belonged to the Imperial Regiment.
19.	"Men, I can see that our voyage is going to be speed and bring great loss to ship and cargo, and to our own lives also." (
20.	When neither sun nor stars appeared for two days and the storm continued raging,
21.	we finally gave up all hope of being saved.(After they had gone a long time with enough food, Paul stood up before them and said: "Men, you should have taken my advice not to sail from Crete; then you would
22.	have spared yourselves this damage and loss. () But now I urge you to keep up your courage, because not one of you will be lost; only the ship would not be destroyed. ()
23.	Last night a soldier of the God to whom I belong and whom I serve stood beside me ()
	In an attempt to jump from the ship, the sailors let the lifeboat down into the sea, pretending they were going to lower some anchors from the bow. (
	Now I urge you to take some food. You need it to survive. Only one of you will lose a single hair from his head." (

27.	they said to each other, "This man must be a warrior Paul went in to see him and, after prayer, placed his hands on him and healed him. (

	To all in Rome who are non Christians and called to be his holy people: Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ. (
	First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is being reported all over the country. (
34.	For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature—not clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that people are without excuse. (
35.	For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became clear and their foolish hearts were darkened. ()
36.	'Or do you show contempt for the riches of his kindness, forbearance and
37.	patience, not realizing that God's kindness is intended to lead you to play? () But because of your stubbornness and your unrepentant heart, you are storing up wrath against yourself for the hour of God's wrath, when his righteous judgment will be revealed. ()
