1. Now about () to idols: We know that "We all possess knowledge." But knowledge puffs up while () builds up. Those who think they know something do not yet know as they ought to know. But whoever () is known by God.
2. Be careful, however, that () does not become a stumbling block to the weak.
3. Don't you know that those who serve in the () get their food from the temple, and that those who serve at the altar share in what is offered on the altar? In the same way, the Lord has commanded that those who () the gospel should receive their ().
4. What then is my ()? Just this: that in preaching the gospel I may offer it free of charge, and so not make full use of () as a preacher of the gospel.
5. Now these things occurred as examples to keep us from setting our () on evil things as they did. Do not be (), as some of them were; as it is written: "The people sat down to eat and drink and got up to () in revelry."
6. A man ought not to cover his (), since he is the image and glory of God; but woman is the glory of man. For man did not come from woman, but woman from man; neither was man created for woman, but woman for man. It is for this reason that a woman ought to have authority over her own head, because of the (). Nevertheless, in the Lord woman is not () of man, nor is man independent of woman. For as woman came from man, so also man is born of woman. But everything comes from ().
7. So then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an () will be () against the body and blood of the Lord.
8. There are different kinds of (), but the same () distributes them. There are different kinds of service, but the same (). There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.
9. And now these three remain: (), () and (). But the () of these is ().
10. I would like every one of you to speak in (), but I would rather have you (). The one who () is greater than the one who speaks in (), unless someone interprets, so that the church may be edified.

8. The eye can say to the hand, “I don’t need you!” And the head cannot say to the feet, “I don’t need you!” ()
9. Love is patient, love is kind. It does envy, it does boast, it is proud. It does dishonor others, it is self-seeking, it is easily angered, it keeps record of wrongs. Love does delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. ()
10. Women should remain silent in the churches. They are not allowed to speak, but must be in submission, as the law says. ()
